In person interactions should be limited to less than 50 people, while maintaining 6 ft separation at all times. All surfaces and devices utilized during the event need to be disinfected before and after use Shared food should not be provided at events to limit potential exposures 	<p>All non-patient care related events should be virtual or with no direct contact between students</p>	<p>All non-patient care related events should be virtual with no direct contact between students</p>
